While most in this line trace back to Manchester before the mid-seventeenth century, the question mark is due to indications that two lines, "Draycott" (119221) and "Montgomery Co., MD, might predate the appearance of Gees in Manchester. Note the three columns marked in yellow. One marker (DSY442) changes between Draycott and Hattersley, another marker (DSY391) changes between Hattersley and Dukinfield/Gee Cross? and one marker changes between Dukinfield and Gee of Virginia Gee (represented by 120350, 126115, 79183 and 175271). We are working to better understand how these branches interrelate.

*The earliest known ancestor of this line is David Gee/Jay, born around 1740, married Lydia ____, lived in Montgomery Co, MD. The earliest records show David using the Gee spelling, records between 1780-1810 show him using both Gee and Jay. After 1810, the family seems to have settled on the surname Jay. This line descends through his son William Jay b 1767 m Anne King in Fredrick Co, MD (across the river from Loudon Co, VA) in 1803. Deeds show the couple lived in Loudon Co for a time. They had three sons: Joseph Jay b 1814 (moved to Iowa), Jonathan King Jay b 1818 (to Minnesota) and Stephen H. Jay b 1820 (also to Minnesota). All descendants are believed to have been active Catholics into the mid-20th century. This information is through the courtesy of the Jay Family Association.

**The earliest known ancestor of this branch is Thomas1 Gee, who with brothers Richard1 and John1 were born in the B34 and 1650's and subsequently appear in parish records in Draycott-in-the-Moors, Staffordshire. Thomas1 married Mary Goodhall 10 Feb 1684. Their son John2 was christened 24 Aug 1686 and married Rebecca ____ in Draycott. Their son John3 Gee was christened 22 Nov 1716 in Draycott. Their son Alexander4 married Ann Salt in Caverswall in 1750. They were living in Staffordshire, possibly Cheadle or Draycott-in-the-Moors, when Philip5 was born on 29 Jan 1758.

** This English branch descends from Thomas Gee, born around 1795 in Hattersley (part of Hyde, Cheshire). He married Betty ____ and farmed 19 acres in Werneth. The oral history in is branch is that their ancestors were the source of the name of the Cheshire town of Gee Cross.

****(Pending)

+This Australian branch may descend from Edward Gee, born around 1670. From parish records, it is likely that he had brothers Thomas and John, and his mother was likely named Mary. His son Nathaniel (b 1700 in Old Chapel Dukinfield) was clerk and sexton of Old Chapel, Dukinfield from 1717 to 1767. Nathaniel likely owned Knotts in Hyde. This is likely near today's Knott Lane, Gee Cross. It is only blocks away from Foxholes, Gerrards and Apethorne. The parish records for Stockport St. Mary are not indexed for the period around 1670, and the original records have not yet been checked, however the years before 1646 have been indexed. They show six Nathaniel's born between 1609 and 1640, which is highly unusual since the name Nathaniel is such an uncommon Gee first name in other locations.

++This branch descends from Charles Gee (d 1709) m Hannah, the founder of the Virginia Gee's. The name Charles was common in Stretford and nowhere else at that time. There is a 21% probability that this line is related to Gee of Westchester and Dutchess Counties, NY.

+++This branch descends from William J. Gee (b 1801, likely in South Carolina), who married Agnes Byars Findley. She was the sister of Jane Byars, who married Eason Gee the younger d 1835 in Texas. William J. may descend from John Henry Gee, son of John3 and Temperance.

++++Descendents of Thomas Jay, born 1779 in Loudon Co, VA, died Bedford Co, PA. This family was Church of the Brethren by the 1860s, little is known about their religious affiliation before then. This information through the courtesy of the Jay Family Association.
